

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
April 30, 2018 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee Dennis Moyer, Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Frank Laney, Diana Warnement, Phyllis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held April 16, 2018 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Seneca County Township Association – meeting invitation, Seneca County Engineer’s Office – two utility permits, Seneca County Board of Elections – memo regarding primary election equipment drop-off information.

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that they have some parades coming up. Also, the department is working on the trucks tonight.

Zoning Inspector Frank Laney reports that he issued one permit since the last meeting. He has been receiving a lot of phone calls about pools and decks.

Trustee Baugher asks if we received Engineer’s estimates for the 2018 road program. Fiscal Officer Bates has not received anything yet. The Board will wait until the next meeting to finalize the program. They would like to do bid opening on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. when bids are opened for the Scipio and Clinton Township joint road program.

Trustee Baugher asked if we got any estimates on a water softener for the township house. Trustee Distel thinks they are around \$500 at Mohawk Supply but he will call and get an exact price.

Trustee Moyer spoke to Dean Miller regarding repairing the driveways on TR 159 where the tile was put in. He may be able to meet tomorrow afternoon.

Jim Darr with the OSS Solid Waste District dropped off a camera and signs at Station #2 today. Jim Lang put them all up, but the camera does not have batteries in it yet. Jim Darr will drop off batteries in a few days. He says they are eventually going to put cameras at all the drop-off locations.

Trustee Distel moved Resolution 2018-7 to bid the paving of TR 177 from TR 106 North to TR 8 together with Scipio Township (Scipio Township Resolution #2018-0420), known as the Clinton/Scipio 2018 Road Program. The bid opening is set for Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. Scipio and Clinton Townships will each fund 50% of the project. Trustee Baugher seconded with roll call as follows: Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.
