

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
February 19, 2018 – 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Dennis Moyer and Trustees Dennis Baugher answered roll call. Trustee James Distel was absent.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Eric Bishop, Frank Laney, Diana Warnement, Phyllis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held February 5, 2018 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Seneca County Engineer – mileage certification, Tiffin Pointe – notification of their application of funding through Ohio Housing Finance Agency

Fiscal Officer Bates reports that Trustee Distel is on vacation but forwarded the following information: Resident Puffenburger on Crestview says that our snowplow tore up his yard. He okay if we wait to fix it in the spring. Trustee Distel recommends that we send a thank you note to Regional Planning for their help with the CBDG income survey and grant for equipment. He also says Charlene Watkins would like everyone to look at their website and specifically at our township information and report any changes needed.

Zoning Inspector Frank Laney reports that he has not issued any new permits. He did get a call about an addition on Spayth St.

Resident Gary Hohman, who lives on CR 50 next to Wagner’s Flowers, says that he believes that the land across the street is going to be developed. It looks like the power company is going to replace the poles that are currently on the northside of the road. He wants to know if we can contact someone at AEP and ask them to move the poles to the southside, since they will need to get power over there anyway. Then they would stop cutting his trees away from the power lines. Trustee Moyer is not sure whom to call. Trustee Baugher says Chris Decker might know and says he will call him. Trustee Moyer asks Zoning Inspector Laney if he has gotten any phone calls about this land. Zoning Inspector Laney says they are looking to split it up.

Regarding sending a thank you note to Regional Planning, Trustee Baugher says the fire department has not yet received any funds from the grant. He also reports that he spoke to Jim Keller, who wants to look at our tanker truck.

Trustee Moyer talked to Ken Crabill regarding the paving of the recycling area at the township house. He is planning to do it in May. Also, Trustee Moyer called Liebrecht about moving some ditches back, but he’s currently out of town and will get back to him next week.

Fiscal Officer Bates reports that she filed the Township’s 2017 Annual Financial Report with the Ohio Auditor of State’s office. A notice will be published in the newspaper that the report is available for public inspection.

Trustee Baugher made a motion to accept the ODOT mileage certification of 34.439 miles as of December 31, 2017. This was seconded by Trustee Moyer. Mr. Baugher – yes, Mr. Moyer – yes.
