

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
September 17, 2018 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee Dennis Moyer, Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Eric Bishop, Frank Laney, Diana Warnement, Phyllis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held September 4, 2018 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Seneca County Regional Planning – memo regarding CDBG grant for 2019, Division of Forestry – meeting information

Trustee Distel moved Resolution #2018-11 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that he has not heard back about scheduling the pump tests.

Zoning Inspector Frank Laney reports that he has issued four permits since the last meeting. Also, the newsletter is done and at the printer.

Resident Dennis Kingseed reports that TR 130 across from Van Camp’s seems like it is sinking. Trustee Moyer says they need to decide what to do there.

Trustee Moyer says he talked to Dave Kinn about TR 122. Kinn is going to call and set up a time to meet and show us some plans. He also said that it is not going to help the resident’s drainage problems, but it will help with our drainage. He has plans that would widen the shoulder, which would be a major project.

Trustee Moyer also got the name of the contractor who is doing the county’s guardrail project. He was advised to also call Great Lakes and get a price from them.

Resident Denny Kirian is taking down trees across from Daryl Moyer’s and asked if it would be okay if he pulled the bank back. Trustee Baugher says we should go look at it.

Trustee Moyer says John Kirian is interested in part-time work. He also says Jim Lang was hauling salt today.

The Board discussed a complaint regarding the loose stone on the curve on TR 207 that poses a hazard for motorcyclists. Trustee Baugher mentioned that the county may be able to spray a tack coat on top. Trustee Moyer says there is stone piled up that will need to be swept off first. He says he can call Unilliance and see if there is something they can do.
