

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
August 19, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Eric Bishop, Dennis Wilkinson, Steve Welter, Larry Frankenfeld, Chris Magers, Phillis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held August 5, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Sandusky River Watershed Coalition – community water forum information, Seneca Co. EMA – emergency mitigation plan meeting information, Seneca County Engineer – estimates for Issue 1 Round 34, OTARMA – annual report

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that the pump tests are done and they all passed.

Zoning Inspector Steve Welter reports he spoke to Steve Borer who was looking for easements on a lot at Woodmere. He referred him to the recorder's office and the auditor's office. He also spoke to Chris Magers about a conditional use permit or possible re-zoning of the property he purchased on TR 122 and issued a deck permit to Eric Gosche.

Resident Chris Magers spoke to the Board about a drainage issue on the Schank farmland. He says the property slopes toward Larry Frankenfeld's property and the tile cannot handle all the water that comes across the road. The Board agreed to meet him at the property to look at it.

The Board discussed using this year's MORE grant toward replacing all of the blue address signs. Trustee Distel says he counted 1537 signs. He also figured up the numbers that we would need as well.

Trustee Moyer asks if Trustee Distel received a quote to fix Station #2, which has hit by a vehicle. Trustee Distel says Craig Clark was out of town but will work on an estimate for us. The sheriff station's cameras do not reach that location. G&L Oil's car wash cameras may reach it, but they was not hopeful that they would see the incident.

Trustee Moyer reports that the American Standard property has not been mowed yet. Trustee Distel says Mark Contact says he gave the information to their attorney in New York. He will try and get a mailing address so we can mail a letter.

Trustee Moyer asks Dennis Kingseed about the location of the driveway tile he is putting in at his property on TR 155. Mr. Kingseed says he is splitting his field so he can put in 10 acres of hay. Trustee Moyer says it is only 5 or 10 feet from the fencerow and if Mr. Kingseed uses it to cause problems with his neighbor, they are taking it back out.

Trustee Distel reports that State Hospital Road will be closed on Thursday, August 22nd for their one mile walk. He also reports that Alex Daniels with Sunrise was supposed to get us information about becoming members but he went back to school and is no longer working there. John Rowland is the rep for our area, so he left him a message to get that information and ask about doing a summer fill.

Regarding the OSS Solid Waste District grant project, Trustee Distel talked to Dean Miller and Fremont Fence about their quotes for the fence and pad at Station #2. Fremont Fence sent an updated quote for the same price. Dean Miller says his quote may come down a little based on the prep work that we are going to do.

Trustee Distel reports that he plans to attend the Seneca County EMA meeting on the 22nd but will let Trustees Moyer and Baugher know if that changes.

Regarding the tax budget, Trustee Baugher moved to accept the 2020 tax budget as presented- Revenue \$662,698.34 and Expenditures \$647,698.34. This was seconded by Trustee Moyer. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.
