

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting  
January 20, 2020 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, Trustee James Distel, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Steve Welter, Dennis Kingseed, and Chris Magers.

The minutes of the regular meeting held January 6, 2020 were read and approved.
