

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
June 10, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Phyllis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held May 28, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: North Central Electric – annual meeting and family fun day, Seneca County Engineer – right-of-way permit, Grassroots Clippings

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that he ordered new accountability tags. They are the Velcro-type tags that most departments in the county are changing to. He also reports that the pump tests are scheduled for August 6th with Finley Fire. They are working on opening a new shop in Findlay and will come up here to do the tests. They quoted a price of \$175 per truck and they are waiving the trip charge because NBS Joint Fire District is joining us. Chief Bishop also says convention is this weekend in Leipsic and asked the Board if they could take the truck for the parade.

Trustee Baugher told resident Phyllis Watts that the logs in the creek by her property were removed. He says we need to get the trees out of there too.

Trustee Baugher reports that the potholes on TR 1108 have been filled. He also reports that Tom Courtney on TR 165 called about a problem with ditch water getting through his driveway tile. Trustee Baugher says the top of the tile is at the flow line of the ditch. The ditch will need to be lowered about 10” or we will have to put a tile in and cover it back up.

Trustee Moyer reports that a resident called about the visibility at the intersection of TR 130 to TR 73. Trustee Moyer told him we would get the ditch mowed. Trustee Moyer also said resident Mr. Stockner called about doing his driveway on Tecumseh. The curb needs to be replaced from his driveway to the catch basin. The Board thinks that the township should take care of it.

Trustee Moyer also reports that out at Honeycreek, resident Irene Allen has complained about her driveway ever since the sewer went in. He say the whole drive is offset by several inches and something needs to be done. The county only guaranteed the work for a year and they will not do anything about it. The Board will look at it and see if there is an issue with the line that is causing the problem. We can also call Mark Zimmerman and see if he will look at it.

Trustee Distel reports that David Zak with the Tiffin-Seneca Economic Partnership called and wants to meet with Hopewell, Eden, and Clinton Townships about the annexation agreement. They would like to meet on July 9th. Trustee Distel reached out to Lori Zoeller with Hopewell Township and Vern Morter with Eden Township to see if they can meet that date at 8:00am and they are going to get back to him.

Trustee Distel says a representative from Palmer Energy emailed him and wants to come to our meeting on July 8th to talk about the energy aggregation agreement that is up for renewal. He is going to talk to us about the electric and gas programs. A gas aggregation would have to get put on the ballot, but he is not sure about the electric aggregation.

Trustee Distel spoke to Zoning Inspector Steve Welter about Winterberry Farms. After speaking to former zoning inspector Frank Laney, they have determined that the property falls under Ag Business and believe that she is in compliance.

Regarding the next round of Issue I funding, Trustee Baugher made a motion to submit the paving of Spayth, Glendale, and Autumnwood for the Issue I, Round 34 project. This was seconded by Trustee Moyer. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

The Board discussed the replacement of the Bishop tile on TR 122. They agreed that the catch basin should be replaced at the same time.
