

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
June 24, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Dennis Baugher and Trustee Dennis Moyer answered roll call. Trustee James Distel was absent. Also present was Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Doug Wilhelm, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held June 10, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Seneca County Engineer’s Office – utility permit, Seneca County Regional Planning – email regarding Issue 1 funding, Beck Suppliers – letter regarding propane pre-buy pricing, Seneca County Commissioners office – memo regarding county ID badges

Trustee Distel was unable to attend the meeting, but he emailed some notes from the Seneca County Township Association meeting on June 21st. Audrey Flood was introduced as the Tiffin Seneca Economic Development Manager. She is looking for information such as new businesses or events we would like to share with the community. Regarding the 2019 Seneca County Fair, Clinton Township is scheduled to work the booth from 6-10pm on Thursday July 25. Also, Tim Lynch from the OTA highlighted some recent changes to legislation that effect townships, such as credit card limits, township road name changes, vacation of a township road, and levies for permanent improvements and general infrastructure in townships. Trustee Distel also reports that everything is set for us to host the September meeting of the county township association. Food is schedule and all we will need to do is clean and set up.

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that John Kirian resigned. He still has a fire extinguisher. Fiscal Officer Bates will send him a letter giving him two weeks to return the extinguisher or pay \$65.

Chief Bishop also reports that they will be hosting a training class on Wednesday June 26th from 6-9pm. Richard Brown from Findley Fire will be teaching about water flow. The City of Tiffin will be sending some firefighters as well.

Resident Doug Wilhelm presented a letter to Resident Dennis Kingseed regarding the fence row between their properties at 2230 N. TR 155. He would like Mr. Kingseed to clear the brush and trees that are growing into his septic system and offers to maintain the fence row once it is cleared. The letter states that per Ohio Revised Code, if Mr. Kingseed is not willing to clear and maintain the fence row, Mr. Wilhelm will address it through the Township Trustees. Trustee Baugher says the Board will go look at it when Trustee Distel is back in town.

Trustee Moyer reports that the weeds on the lot at CR 17 and CR 50 need mowed. He also reports that 469 Harley has high grass as well. Regarding Tom Courtney’s property on TR 165, Trustee Moyer says we will not need to put in a tile.

Trustee Baugher asked who owns the property at CR 17 and CR 50. Fiscal Officer Bates looked on the county auditor’s website and reports that it is owned buy David Ritchie.

Trustee Moyer moved Resolution #2019-7 , a resolution declaring the property owned by David Ritchie, Located at 0 E. CR 50 in Clinton Township, Seneca County, Ohio, a nuisance pursuant to O.R.C. 505.87. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Baugher – yes, Mr. Distel – absent, Mr. Moyer – yes.
