

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
November 25, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Steve Welter, Dennis Kingseed, Ed Ollom.

The minutes of the meeting held November 11, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: Seneca County Prosecutor – reminder for joint public hearing on December 4, 2019, Seneca County Township Association – meeting invitation, Department of Commerce Division of Liquor Control – notice for liquor license renewals

Fire Chief Fred Bishop reports that Truck #32 is back from Keller’s. He has not heard anything about it so he assumes the brakes are okay.

Zoning Inspector Steve Welter reports that the zoning board is holding a meeting on December 12, 2019 at 7:00pm for the consideration of Gary Gruss and BEKS Ltd.’s re-zoning application. Regarding Winterberry Farms, Sabrina Schnepat is available to meet anytime after December 10th. Zoning Inspector Welter also received another email regarding a cell tower on CR 13. He also reports that he attended the Seneca County Economic Development meeting regarding the Comprehensive Plan.

Trustee Baugher reports that Neil Podach is going to look at boring under TR 122 and call him tomorrow to discuss it. He also says Chad Everhart took care road striping at Deer Ridge and it looks good.

Trustee Moyer says the numbers are wearing off the keyless entry key pads that we got for free. The one we bought at Republic Lumber is okay. Trustee Distel will contact the rep to see if he can do anything about it. The Board also discussed ordering another keyless entry lock from Republic Lumber for the door on the east side of the township house.

Trustee Moyer also asked about doing a newsletter at the end of the year. The spring newsletter did not go out until August, so we can wait a few months.

Ed Ollom introduced himself. He running for State Representative in the Republican primary election on March 17, 2020. He says he is not a politician; he is an environmental engineer who grew up outside of Fremont and graduated from Lakota. He has a bachelor’s and master’s degree in environmental science. He is currently the Seneca County local emergency planning committee chairman, the secretary of the homeland security committee for Seneca County, and past president of the Tiffin Area Safety Council. He agenda is based on rural communities.
