

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
September 16, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Steve Welter, Chris Magers, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held September 3, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: OSS Solid Waste District – memo regarding appliance collection, Seneca County Board of Elections – memo regarding General Election

Zoning Inspector Steve Welter reports he spoke to Bob Reinhart from Fostoria regarding the Honeycreek lots. He has been told by Hank & Associates that the lots are not in the floodplain, and he will have applications for building permits completed soon. Zoning Inspector Welter also reports that he issued permits for a fence and a pool to Matt Thom, a permit for a utility shed to the Commission on Aging, a permit for a utility shed garage to Desiree Shumaker, and a permit for a propane tank to Tom Lee.

Trustee Baugher reports that he and Jim Lang went out to Clinton Heights Golf Course and checked the flow lines of the tile on each side of the road and there is about nine inches of fall from the south side to the north. They met with Soil & Water, who suggested that they bore across the road with a 12” tile and elbow it into the ditch.

Trustee Moyer reports that we got estimates from Unilliance for the driveway approaches on TR 122. He also reports that the blue address signs are in, but Lightle Enterprises has to cut the corners and put the holes in yet. Trustee Moyer also reports that we ordered 50 tons of road salt this year. Jim Lang is going to start hauling it soon. Also, the insurance adjusted called and said he does not have an estimate for the repairs at Station #2 yet. Trustee Baugher says he turned it in to Joe Worland’s office, so we need to follow up with them.

Trustee Moyer says he called the county about Dave Kinn doing the survey for TR 122, and they do not have a resolution asking him to do so. The Board thought that we did a resolution, and Fiscal Officer Bates will look into it.

Trustee Distel reports that the next Seneca County EMA meeting is scheduled for September 30th at 6:00pm at NCOESC. He also reports that he spoke to Steve Bell at M & B Asphalt about the invoice for the 2019 road paving being so far over the bid. He adjusted it down to \$224,000, which includes putting the riser in for the lid and the 2 driveway approaches. Also, Trustee Distel reports that the striping estimate came in at approximately \$7,800. Trustee Distel also says that the American Standard lot has been mowed.
