

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
September 30, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee James Distel, Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Dennis Moyer, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Fred Bishop, Chris Magers, Diana Warnement, Phyllis Watts, and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the meeting held September 16, 2019 were read and approved.

Correspondence: MWG Administrators – life insurance renewal, Sandusky River Watershed Coalition – info regarding October events, Sunrise Cooperative – propane contract, OTARMA – memo regarding Bonds/Faithful Performance Coverage

Fire Chief Fred Bishop thanked the Board for their help with the ox roast.

Trustee Baugher says Chuck Theis can pump the septic tanks at the township house soon if we want him to do so.

Trustee Moyer moved Resolution #2019-10, a resolution declaring the property owned by Eric Zeis, located at 94 E. Cherry Ave. in Clinton Township, Seneca County, Ohio, a nuisance pursuant to O.R.C. 505.87. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

Trustee Moyer moved Resolution 2019-11, a resolution to have the Seneca County Engineer’s office design the plans to move the ditch back on the north side of TR 122, from 2521 E. TR 122 to 2683 E. TR 122. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

Trustee Moyer asks if we received anything from the zoning board regarding the zoning change hearing held on September 26th. Fiscal Officer Bates has not received anything.

Trustee Distel reports that he received a phone call on Friday night regarding a pole that was down on a fence between Harley and Huron just off Greeley. AEP took care of it. He also reports that the NCOR COG annual meeting is scheduled for March 5, 2020 at 8:00am.

Trustee Distel says Lee Stover gave us a quote of \$7,900 to pave the driveway approaches on TR 122. He can get to it in the next week or two. Also, regarding the dead trees on TR 159 near Frank Laney’s house, Jim Lang says he is planning on taking them out. Road striping has been started but TR 165 is not done. Trustee Distel will call and make sure they did not forget about it. Trustee Distel also reports that on October 3rd the propane tanks and furnaces are going to be tested.

Trustee Moyer moved Resolution #2019-9 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Moyer – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

Trustee Distel attended the Seneca County EMA hazard mitigation meeting and gave them a list of the areas where we have been effected by tornadoes – Honeycreek, Spayth, and Greenlawn, and flooding on River Rd. and Buskirk Rd.
