

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting
January 2, 2023 – 7:00 p.m.

All Board members answered roll call – Trustee Dennis Baugher, Trustee Jim Distel, Trustee Dan Schmitz, and Fiscal Officer Jennifer Bates.

Guests: Ben Bishop, Chris Hafley, and Ray Bishop.

Correspondence: Gene Englehart -thank you card, OSS Solid Waste District – email regarding recycling drop-off and memo regarding grant opportunity, ODOT – mileage certification, Seneca County Engineer – utility permits

The minutes of the organizational meeting held January 2, 2023 were read and approved.

Ray Bishop says the voicemail at the township house is not working.

Fire Chief Chris Hafley reports that he is working on numbers for his year-end report. Ben Bishop says they had a total of 420 runs in 2022 and Chief Hafley says they have already had 2 runs this year.

Trustee Baugher asks what the next step is on TR 155. Trustee Distel says he emailed the prosecutor's office. Trustee Baugher asks who we are going to get to move the combine if Mr. Kingseed does not move it. Trustee Schmitz says he assumes we will have Keller's do it. Trustee Baugher says he is concerned about damaging the combine and that it could get expensive. Trustee Schmitz asks if we should have Creager's move it. He also says he thinks the only right way to do it is to have a third party move it and that Keller's could move it to their secured yard. Trustee Baugher says this is fine with him and Trustee Distel says once we hear from the prosecutor, we can tell Mr. Kingseed that if it is not moved by a certain date that we will have Keller's move it.

Trustee Distel made a motion to accept the ODOT mileage certification of 34.422 miles as of December 31, 2022. This was seconded by Trustee Baugher. Mr. Schmitz – yes, Mr. Distel – yes, Mr. Baugher – yes.

Trustee Distel says he will look into the OSS Solid Waste District grants for each recycling location. He also tells Ray Bishop that the tile for the new fire station building has been moved and asked him to check it. He also tells Mr. Bishop that there is a dead tree along the property line, at the southeast corner of the salt shed that will need attention. Fiscal Officer Bates will send a letter. Mr. Bishop asks if we know where the property line is and Trustee Baugher says Jim Hohman is going to scale it out. Trustee Distel say the tile was moved way off the property line to a natural swale.

Trustee Baugher asks what we are going to do with the semi load of insulation. He says he would like the 18 new rolls to be used in the existing garage bays. He asks if the firemen would be interested in any of the remaining insulation and Ben Bishop says they can ask. Trustee Distel says if they do not want it all, he would be willing to make a donation for anything left. He also says Clouse Construction has talked about moving the trailers to their yard.
