

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting  
June 17, 2024 – 6:00 p.m.

Trustee Dan Schmitz, Trustee Jim Distel and Trustee Randy Kuhn answered Roll Call.

Guests: Chris Hafley, Ray Bishop, Jeff Hohman, Jennifer Bates, Sherriff Fred Stephens and Dennis Kingseed.

The minutes of the regular meeting held June 3, 2024 were read and approved.

#### Correspondence

Fiscal Officer Welter left no correspondence. Fiscal Officer Welter left a note that we did not declare the property on Township Road 50 a nuisance and left letters to be mailed if we do that tonight. He called the number and was told that the company contracted to take care of the property was on vacation. The management company is looking for another contractor to mow it.

Jim Distel made a motion to declare the property at 3872 E County Road 50 a Nuisance. Trustee Schmitz seconded, Trustee Schmitz Y, Trustee Distel Y, Trustee Kuhn Y. Motion carried.

Sherriff Fred Stevens reported that Clinton Township had 1213 calls for service. This year so far 9727 township calls. He presented a report for Clinton Township showing the break down of calls. Sherriff Stevens said that the number of calls for Deer accidents has increased considerably. He reported that he was going to ask ODNR for help. Sherriff Stevens said he would provide data show the increase in the number of accidents. He said they could allow hunters to hunt more deer during deer season.

One of the other technology improvements is a property check that you will get an e-mail that they have checked your property. They have added text to dispatched and live dispatch. People at the scene can show us what is going on at the scene.

As far as the Jail goes the commissioner have approved 1.8 million to fix the boilers. They have had 1,810 bookings. Medical has been greatly improved. When he came in we had one RN and one LPN to manage the 190 inmates. Now we have a medical director one RN and a contract with Dr Sears and an LPN and two paramedics.

Sherriff Stevens reported that they brought back a GED program after covid.

He also reported that they started a Mobile Crises program. MCRT has trained mental health personnel that go out in unmarked cars. They come to the scene when called. Total number of calls were 247. The crises calls were 46. The people are given cards and they do follow ups with them. This helps reduce the number of call backs.

Trustee Kuhn asked about project life saver. Through the Lion's clubs of Seneca county. They have purchased equipment such as drones and bands. This is mostly used for Autistic people that wonder off.

Mr. Kingseed asked what the total budget was. Sherriff Stevens said 7.1 million total budget was this year. They are bringing back 2.1 million through grants.

Zoning inspector Hohman reported that he did 1 permit.

Chief Hafley reported that as of yesterday they were at 210 calls for service and at this same time last year 117. One mutual aide from Old Fort. There were fourteen firefighters that responded. They managed the water supply to there pumper.

Chief Hafley reported that the Amicus dealer mounted the new tools to our truck. He said they moved the old cutting tool to engine 32 in the back. They are working on scheduling a time to set up training on the new equipment.

Chief Hafley reported that MES came in and did the face mask testing to be in compliance. Three people failed the test they had two large of a mask. They are correcting that.

Chief Hafley reported that they did receive the \$1000.00 OTARMA grant.

Trustee Distel asked if zoning inspector Hohman was doing ok in his position. Zoning inspector Hohman said Steve has been helping him. He said he gets about five or six calls a week with questions.

Dennis Kingseed asked Chief Hafley if they know what caused the fire on CR 38. Chief Hafley said no he did not.

Dennis Kingseed said that there was a tree on 159 that is really close to the road. It is very hard to see to pull out. The Trustees said they would check it out.

Trustee Schmitz said he went out to Blue bird court and looked at the tile and driveway. All the rest of the driveways are not tiled.

Trustee Distel said he gave everyone copies of all the roads we wanted bids on. He said he has all the information for the OSS grant. Fiscal Officer Welter got him the minutes for the Grant. He said he will get it turned in next week.

Trustee Distel reported that September 17<sup>th</sup> the are going to seal the parking lot at station number 1 and September 19 they are going to seal the parking lot at station 2.
