December 2, 2024 – 6:00 p.m.

The Following board members answered Roll Call Trustee Jim Distal, Trustee Dan Schmitz, Trustee Randy Kuhn and Fiscal Officer Steve Welter.

The minutes of the regular meeting held November 18, 2024 were read and approved.

Correspondence

Received a letter from the Ohio Department of Commerce about liquor permits expiring February 1st 2025.

Received a letter from Bureau of Workers Compensation about the one claim program changed its name for 2024. We are also approved for the one claim program.

Received a letter from the Ohio Township Association about the upcoming election along with a ballot to vote.

Zoning Meeting Scheduled for 12/11/24 on Solar Regulations

Assistant Chief Wilkinson reported that the department responded to 420 calls year-to-date. Last year at this time year-to-date calls were 437. Calls reported to the State Fire Marshals office year-to-date were 357 last year at this time year-to-date calls were 327. Assistant Chief Wilkinson reported that he completed the sprinkler system check on one of the buildings that Sentinel is building. Assistant Chief Wilkinson said he wanted to thank the trustees for all of there cooperation this year it has been very good working with all of you.

Trustee Schmitz said he spoke with Renee Miller with the Seneca County Land Reutilization and their funding has passed and waiting on the agreement to be signed that we may see activity on the property on township road 122 yet this year. Trustee Schmitz reported that we had some damage to the surface of Township Road 73 from a logging truck, Deer Creek Logging company. It has been repaired. He will call Brian Wise and talk to him about it. Trustee Schmitz said he tried to make some inquiries as to wither they can log that out and what the proper way to do it is. He reported that the Ohio Department of Natural Resources has been no help. Today he was referred to the State Forestry services. Trustee Schmitz said he has had contact with a couple of residents about the intersection of State Route 18 and county road 15 and Township Road 17. They said that people are running the stop sign. They inquired about putting in rumble strips. Assistant Chief Wilkinson said people would still run the stop sign he suggested we call the Sherriff and ask them to monitor that intersection. Discussion was held on rumble strips and complaints from residents living near rumble strips and the noise and vibration. The Trustees said that they would look into something to possible help.

Trustee Schmitz reported that a resident at 769 Township Road 122 asked about the water that accumulates in a low area near their property and if there was anything that can be done. Discussion was held on what is happening. The Trustees said they would look at it.
